TO PROVIDE FOR MORE EFFECTIVE CONTROL OF STATE EXPENDITURES

OFFICE OF

WHEREAS, it is the foremost goal of this administration to ensure that expenditures are made in the most efficient and beneficial manner to the people of Maine including beneficiaries as well as taxpayers of the State of Maine, and;

WHEREAS, each department of government should constantly review and revise its work programs so that essential services are delivered in the most economical manner,

NOW. THEREFORE, I, JAMES B. LONGLEY, Governor of the State of Maine do hereby instruct the Department of Finance and Administration through the Bureau of the Budget to require, within its discretion and to the extent it deems desirable, departments of government to review itemized details of the Personal Services, All Other and Capital Quarterly Allotments.

I further direct all departments of government not to spend such quarterly allotments for purposes other than for the itemized categories without permission from the Department of Finance and Administration through the Bureau of the Budget, and to target further budgetary reductions for the balance of this fiscal year. The Department of Finance and Administration through the Bureau of the Budget will issue further instructions regarding compliance with this Order.
