

Distribution of Oil Overcharge Funds

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that funds will be made available to the State of Maine as partial reparation for past overcharges on the price of petroleum products; and

WHEREAS, the use of these funds represents an excellent opportunity to make energy-related improvements of statewide significance; and

WHEREAS, these funds should be distributed as expeditiously as possible;


NOW, THEREFORE, I JOSEPH E. BRENNAN, Governor of the State of Maine, hereby order that the Cabinet Committee on Oil Overcharges is established as follows:

1. Membership. The membership shall consist of:

- Commissioner of Finance and Administration
- Commissioner of the Department of Transportation
- Director of the Office of Energy Resources
- Director of the Division of Community Services
- Director of the Maine State Housing Authority
- Representative from the Governor's Office

The Director of the Office of Energy Resources will chair the Committee.

2. Duties. The Committee shall develop a plan for distribution and utilization of any oil overcharge funds received or expected to be received by the State consistent with guidelines and rules required by court decisions or Federal laws.
3. Report. The Committee shall make recommendations to the Governor on a proposed distribution plan, along with any necessary legislation, within 90 days of notification of the availability of funds.
