### SPECIAL BUDGET AND EXPENDITURE ORDER OF 1990

WHEREAS, it is wise to plan for the economic uncertainty currently being experienced in the Northeast region and for continued cost shifting from the Federal to State Governments;

WHEREAS, it is prudent to plan now for the fiscal restraint that may be necessary in the months ahead;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOHN R. MCKERNAN, JR., Governor of the State of Maine, do hereby order and direct that each agency and department refrain from filling vacant positions funded by or affecting the General Fund without the approval of the Director of the Bureau of Human Resources and the Governor's Office, as described in HUMAN RESOURCES MEMORANDUM 10-89.

Should any department or agency head feel that compliance with this will result in an unreasonable hardship, the particular circumstance should be immediately made known to the Governor's Office following the procedures described in HUMAN RESOURCES MEMORANDUM 10-89.

This order, effective October 1, 1989, will remain in effect through April 30, 1990, unless specifically amended, terminated or extended by Executive Order.
