This booklet contains the history and final disposition of legislative documents and papers introduced into the Maine Legislature during a specified period as developed by the Legislative Information Office. The Legislative Information Office, in its efforts to monitor and provide an accurate account of such legislative activities, has assembled and published this concise handbook with the aid of computer technology pursuant to joint legislative order.

The Legislative Information Office, in conjunction with Central Computer Services, utilizes the state computer to furnish legislators, state officials, the press and the public during each legislative session with detailed status information on each piece of legislation pending before the Legislature. This reporting system provides grouping of pending legislation in the following four categories: Subject matter, sponsor, committee of reference and document number. All information is updated each legislative day by the office and is quickly and accurately made available to any inquiror, either through Information Office personnel or through use of a self-service computer terminal located in room 315 of the State House.

The bill status system has proved invaluable in providing summary information and in following legislation through the legislative process. The Office of Legislative Information welcomes any suggestions on how to make the system even more useful to the Legislature and to the public and hopes that this booklet will benefit all who have occasion to use it.

For ease of use you will note each entry has been inserted in a given order: Index by major, minor and detail subjects - Title - Paper and Legislative Document numbers - Sponsor, Cosponsor - Committee of Reference - Hearing date - Committee report - Amendments - Final disposition.
