**AN ACT Relating to Area Recreational Signs for Rangeley Area.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. R. S., c. 23, § 149-A, amended.** The first sentence of section 149-A of chapter 23 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 419 of the public laws of 1957 and as amended by chapter 258 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended to read as follows:

'In order to guide the users of the state turnpike system to the exit leading therefrom to the ~~16~~ 17 major recreational areas of the State, there shall be erected and maintained at strategic points on the rights-of-way beside the lanes of traffic approaching the said exits, separate descriptive and directional signs of such design that each sign will be conspicuous and readable when traveling at the maximum lawful speed.'

**Sec. 2. R. S., c. 23, § 149-A, amended.** The 2nd paragraph of section 149-A of chapter 23 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 419 of the public laws of 1957 and as amended by chapter 258 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended to read as follows:

'The ~~16~~ 17 major recreational areas of the State are:'

**Sec. 3. R. S., c. 23, § 149-A, sub-§ IX-A, additional.** Section 149-A of chapter 23 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 419 of the public laws of 1957 and as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection to be numbered IX-A, to read as follows:

'IX-A. Rangeley, Bald Mountain and Saddleback Mountain Ski Areas.'
