AN ACT Relating to Having Weapons in Motor Vehicles for Hunting.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 78, amended. The 4th sentence of section 78 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:

'No person, except a law enforcement officer in the line of duty or a person having a valid permit to carry a concealed weapon, may have in or on any motor vehicle or trailer any loaded pistol or revolver ~~with a barrel length of over 4 inches.~~
