AN ACT Repealing the Time Limitation on Statute Repealing the Two Inch Clam Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

P. L., 1959, c. 354, § 3, repealed. Section 3 of chapter 354 of the public laws of 1959 is repealed as follows :

~~'Sec. 3. Effective date. This act shall become effective March 1, 1960 and remain in effect until January 1, 1962.'~~
