AN ACT Reestablishing Western Maine Sanatorium in Hebron.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Western Maine Sanatorium reestablished. Western Maine Sanatorium, located at Hebron and discontinued as a sanatorium by the 99th Legislature, is reestablished as a sanatorium under Revised Statutes, chapter 25, sections 105-C and 105-D.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Welfare to carry out the purposes of this act the sum of \$440,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962 and the sum of \$440,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1963; the breakdown of which shall be as follows:
