RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension for Paul Tobin of Otisfield.

Paul Tobin; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$50 per month be granted to Paul Tobin, of Otisfield, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin July 1, 1961 and continue until otherwise provided by the Legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Tobin is now receiving aid to the blind. He is 66 years of age. He has broken his leg and is now becoming an invalid.
