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**AN ACT Relating to Marking Contents of Certain Cans of Fish or Sardines.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 32, § 263, amended.** The first paragraph of section 263 of chapter 32 of the Revised Statutes, as last amended by section 3 of chapter 92 of the public laws of 1957, is further amended by adding at the end of the first paragraph the following:

**'It shall be unlawful to place covers indicating the contents as 4 fish or 4 sardines on cans containing more than 4 fish. The shipping containers used for cans which indicate the contents as 4 fish or 4 sardines shall be plainly and conspicuously marked with letters no less than ½ inch in height with the words 4 FISH CANS. It shall be unlawful to place cans containing more than 4 fish in shipping containers marked with the words 4 FISH CANS.'**
