RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Temple Pond, Somerset County.

Temple Pond; fishing regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to close Temple Pond in the Town of Moscow, Somerset County, to fishing by all persons over the age of 16, with a 5 fish daily bag limit. Live bait prohibited.
