**RESOLVE, Authorizing the Maine Military Defense Commission to Convey
Certain Land in Bangor.**

Maine Military Defense Commission authorized to convey certain land. Resolved: That the Maine Military Defense Commission be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to convey by quitclaim deed to the City of Bangor, the interest of the State in a certain lot or parcel of land situated on the northwesterly side of Main Street, in said Bangor, bounded and described as follows, viz:

Beginning at a bolt in the northwesterly line of Main Street at a point one hundred two and sixty-seven one hundredths (102.67) feet northeasterly of the intersection of the northeasterly line of Dillingham Street with said line of Main Street, measured on said line of Main Street, said point being also the corner of a lot of land owned by Springer Realty Company; thence northwesterly parallel with said line of Dillingham Street and along the line of said Springer Realty Company lot one hundred and twenty-five (125) feet to a stake; thence northeasterly parallel with said line of Main Street sixty-five (65) feet to a point thence southeasterly parallel with the first described line one hundred and twenty-five (125) feet to a point in the northwesterly line of Main Street; thence southwesterly on and by said line of Main Street sixty-five (65) feet to the point of beginning.

Being a part of the same premises conveyed to the State of Maine by the city of Bangor by deed dated October 28, 1931 and recorded in Penobscot County Registry of Deeds, Vol. 1052, Page 494.

Statement of Facts.

This is part of the land conveyed by the City of Bangor to the State in 1931 for an Armory. This lot is no longer needed for this purpose.
