IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Creating a Constitutional and State Government Committee.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Sec. 1. Committee. The Governor shall appoint a committee of not more than 15 persons to study the Constitution, organization, administration and financial system of the State of Maine.

Sec. 2. Report. The committee shall report to the next regular session of the Legislature such changes and amendments to the Constitution and laws of the State as may appear to be necessary or desirable to improve the services of State Government to the people of Maine. For this purpose the committee may employ such technical and clerical assistance as it may deem necessary.

Sec. 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$25,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962 to carry out the purposes of this act. Such appropriation shall not lapse, but shall remain a continuing carrying account until June 30, 1963.
