STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Fees for Replacement Motor Vehicle License Plates and Inserts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 22, § 13, amended. The 13th paragraph of section 13 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Extra Replacement number plates shall be furnished to replace lost or mutilated plates for 75e **\$1** each

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 22, § 13, amended. Section 13 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding after the 13th paragraph, a new paragraph, as follows:

'Replacement inserts for number plates shall be furnished to replace lost or mutilated inserts for 50c each.'

Sec. 3. R. S., c. 22, § 18, amended. The 7th paragraph of section 18 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'If any number plate is lost or the register number thereon becomes mutilated or illegible, the owner or person in control of the vehicle for which said number plate was furnished shall immediately place a temporary number plate bearing his register number upon said vehicle. Such temporary number plate shall conform to the register number plate and shall be displayed as nearly as possible as provided in this chapter for said regular number plate, and such person shall

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within 24 hours after such loss or mutilation give notice thereof to the Secretary of State and apply for new number plates; and thereupon. Thereupon the Secretary of State, if satisfied of the truth of the facts stated in the application, shall supply a new set of number plates upon payment of a fee of 75e \$I for each plate.
