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**AN ACT Relating to Operation of Vehicles Loaned by a Dealer or Holder of a  
Transit Registration Certificate.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 22, § 29, sub-§ II, amended.** Subsection II of section 29 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 8 of chapter 200 of the public laws of 1955, is further amended by adding at the end thereof the following sentence:

**'The Secretary of State may in his discretion extend said period of 7 consecutive days to no more than 30 consecutive days whenever he feels the need for such extension is justified.'**
