AN ACT Permitting Sale of Malt Liquor in Restaurants on Sunday Afternoons.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 61, § 27, amended. The first sentence of section 27 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 311 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended to read as follows:

'No liquor shall be sold in this State on Sundays and no licensee by himself, clerk, servant or agent shall between the hours of midnight and 6 A. M. sell or deliver any liquors, except no liquors shall be sold or delivered on Saturdays after 11:45 P. M., and except that malt liquor may be sold in restaurants on Sundays from 12 o'clock noon to 6 P. M.'
