# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

#### AN ACT Relating to Motor Vehicle Operators' Licenses for Members of the Armed Forces.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 22, § 60, amended.** The last paragraph of section 60 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Provided further, that on On application to the Secretary of State, any person who is serving in the armed forces of the United States in time of war or national emergency and who is otherwise qualified to operate a motor vehicle in this State shall receive a license without the requirement of the payment of any fee. Such person shall, notwithstanding the expiration date of such license, be entitled to operate a motor vehicle without obtaining a new license therefor. Such person shall, while operating a motor vehicle, carry upon his person conclusive evidence that he is a member of said armed forces. The privileges of this paragraph shall remain in effect for a period of 30 days after the discharge or release of such person from said armed forces. Nothing in this paragraph shall be construed to permit a person against whom a revocation or suspension of a license is in force, or a person who has been refused a license by the Secretary of State, to operate a motor vehicle.'
