**AN ACT Increasing Fee of Physicians in Commitment Proceedings of Insane
Criminals.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 27, § 126, amended. The first sentence of section 126 of chapter 27 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The fee of each physician for such examination and certificate and testifying before said judge shall be ~~\$5~~ \$25.'
