COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 565, L. D. 785, Bill, "An Act
Appropriating Moneys to Effectuate Compensation for State
Employees."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 1 and insert-
ing in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 1. Allocation for a pay plan. There is allocated
from the funds provided by the Legislature in the Supplemental
Appropriation Act sufficient funds to effectuate as of the first
pay period ending after July 1, 1961 a new pay plan, for classified
and unclassified positions; such plan to be approved by the State
Personnel Board.'
