RESOLVE, Increasing Pension of Martha Morey of Shirley Mills.

Martha Morey; pension increased. Resolved: That the pension now being paid to Martha Morey of Shirley Mills as a totally and permanently disabled person be increased from \$65 per month to \$80 per month until such time as she reaches age 62 and will be eligible for social security.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. Morey lives alone and the money she receives is for her food, clothing and heat for her home. She has 2 married daughters but neither are in a position to help her greatly, if at all. Mrs. Morey's husband is a veteran of World War I but had but 87 days service so she is not entitled to any pension from that source.
