**RESOLVE, Providing Funds for Biological and Management Investigation of
Certain Fish.**

Biological and management investigation of certain fish; funds for. Resolved: That the sum of \$26,000 is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund for the purpose of establishing and maintaining a biological and management investigation of anadromous fish (smelts, shad, alewives, striped bass and salmon) for the fiscal years 1961-62 and 1962-63, under the direction of the Commissioner of Sea and Shore Fisheries; and be it further

Resolved: That the Commissioner of Sea and Shore Fisheries is directed to obtain sufficient personnel and equipment for the investigation with a view of establishing necessary procedures to provide adequate conservation and management of the several species.
