**AN ACT Relating to Penalty for First Offense for Driving Motor Vehicle Under  
the Influence of Intoxicating Liquor.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 22, § 150, amended.** The first sentence of section 150 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Whoever shall operate or attempt to operate a motor vehicle upon any way, or in any other place when intoxicated or at all under the influence of intoxicating liquor or drugs, upon conviction, shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$100 nor more than \$1,000, or by imprisonment for not less than ~~30~~ 10 days nor more than 11 months, or by both ~~such fines and imprisonment.~~'
