STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT to Authorize Enfield, Greenbush, Greenfield, Howland, Maxfield, Passadumkeag, LaGrange and Seboeis Plantation to Form a School Administrative District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

School administrative district for Enfield, Greenbush, etc. authorized. The municipalities of Enfield, Greenbush, Greenfield, Howland, Maxfield, Passadumkeag, LaGrange and Seboeis Plantation are exempted from the limitations provided in the Revised Statutes of 1954, chapter 41, section 111-E, as amended, and the Maine School District Commission is authorized to proceed pursuant to sections 111-F to 111-U to take the necessary action to allow the municipalities of Enfield, Greenbush, Greenfield, Howland, Maxfield, Passadumkeag, LaGrange and Seboeis Plantation to form a school administrative district.

The Maine School District Commission is authorized to accept applications from the Town of Howland and any 3 or more of the towns named herein. The commission is further authorized to approve the formation of a School Administrative District consisting of the Town of Howland any any 3 or more of the towns named in this act.

Nothing contained herein shall be construed to limit the number of times that the above-named municipalities may make application to the Maine School District Commission nor shall the authority granted the Maine School District Commission under this act be limited to any specified number of times for the commission to authorize the above-named municipalities to act on the formation of a school administrative district.
