AN ACT Increasing Renewal Fee of Certificate of Registration for Barbers and Operators of Hairdressing and Beauty Culture.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 25, § 225, amended. The last sentence of the first paragraph of section 225 of chapter 25 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows :

'Said certificate of registration shall be renewed on or before the first day of January in each year, and the holder of said certificate of registration shall pay to the secretary of said board the sum of ~~§~~ \$5 for said renewal.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 25, § 225, amended. The 2nd sentence of the 2nd paragraph of section 225 of chapter 25 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows :

'Said certificate of registration shall be renewed on or before the first day of July in each year, and the holder of said certificate of registration shall pay to the secretary of said board the sum of ~~§~~ \$5 for said renewal.'
