AN ACT Relating to License Fees of Recreational and Eating Places.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 25, § 162, amended. Section 162 of chapter 25 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 162. License; terms and fees. The department is empowered to license eating and lodging places, recreational and overnight camps. Such licenses shall be issued by the department under such terms and conditions as it deems advisable, and fees for licenses not exceeding ~~\$10~~ \$15 may be charged. **Any establishment required to have a license by this section which has a private system of water supply shall be considered as selling water for domestic purposes and subject to the requirements of section 141.** The fees thus received shall constitute a permanent fund to carry out ~~the provisions of~~ sections 160 to 166.'
