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**RESOLVE, in Favor of J. Douglas Paton of Fredericton, New Brunswick,  
Canada.**

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**J. Douglas Paton; reimbursed. Resolved:** That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$250 to be paid to J. Douglas Paton, of Fredericton, New Brunswick, Canada, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for damages to his automobile which was involved in an accident in the Town of Dixfield caused by the icy highway.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The accident took place in the Town of Dixfield on December 20, 1960. The ice at the edge of Dixfield was of such thickness and width as to indicate that normal sanding, salting and snow removal was not carried out. Mr. Paton's car was damaged considerably.
