COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 828, L.D. 1143, Bill, "An
Act Permitting Sale of Liquor for One Hour After Midnight."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the
first line the abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof the
following:

"Sec. 2. R.S., c. 61, §27, amended. The 6th sentence
of section 27 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes, as en-
acted by section 2 of chapter 403 of the public laws of 1955,
is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof: 'The
hours of selling or delivering above referred to shall be
United States Eastern Daylight Time between the last Sunday
of April and the last Sunday of October in each year and
shall be United States Eastern Standard Time during the
remainder of each year.' "
