AN ACT Prohibiting Stocking Certain Waters with Fish.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 62, amended. Section 62 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read as follows:

'No fish or fish spawn raised by the State shall be planted or deposited in such pools or ponds unless the owner shall permit the public to fish therein.'
