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**AN ACT Relating to the Insurance Commissioner.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. R. S., c. 60, § 2, amended.** The 7th sentence of section 2 of chapter 60 of the Revised Statutes, as last amended by section 13 of chapter 361 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended to read as follows:

'He (Insurance Commissioner) shall ~~receive~~ be paid an annual salary of \$10,000 as determined by the Governor and confirmed by the Council and his travel expenses incurred in the performance of his duties.'

**Sec. 2. R. S., c. 60, § 327, sub-§ VI, additional.** Section 327 of chapter 60 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection VI, to read as follows:

**'VI. Chief insurance examiner.** The commissioner shall appoint, with the approval of the Governor and Council, and may remove for cause, a chief insurance examiner who has the qualifications of a senior examiner as prescribed by the Manual of the National Association of Insurance Commissioners' Examination Practice and Procedure.'
