AN ACT Exempting Electricity for Homes from Sales Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 17, § 10, sub-§ IX, amended. Subsection IX of section 10 of chapter 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

IX. Coal, oil, wood and electricity. Coal, oil, wood, **electricity** and all other fuels, except gas ~~and electricity~~, when bought for cooking and heating in homes, hotels and apartment houses, and other buildings designed both for human habitation and sleeping.'
