AN ACT to Clarify State Boating Law.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 36-A, § 2, amended.** The last paragraph of section 2 of chapter 36-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 349 of the public laws of 1959, is amended to read as follows:

“Waters of this State” means any inland body of water, wholly or partly within the territorial limits of this State, and all rivers and streams above tide-water, **except that for the purpose of issuing a certificate of number as hereinafter provided “waters of this State” shall mean any body of water, wholly or partly within the territorial limits of this State.**’
