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**AN ACT** Relating to Basis of Population in Determining Educational Subsidies  
for Town of Limestone.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 41, § 237-H-1, additional.** Chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section to be numbered 237-H-1, to read as follows:

‘Sec. 237-H-1. **Population basis for Town of Limestone.** In determining any educational or school subsidy under this chapter, the population of the Town of Limestone shall be as shown by the last Federal Census and the school population shall be determined accordingly.’
