SENATE AMENDMENT "C" to S. P. 405, L. D. 1346, Bill, "An Act Relating to Form of Standard Fire Insurance Policy."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line the abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out the 9th, 10th, and 11th lines and inserting in place thereof the following underlined words:

'No.....'

(Space for insertion of name of company or companies issuing the policy and other matter permitted to be stated at the head of policy)

(Space for listing amounts of insurance, rates, premiums for the basic coverages insured under the standard form of policy and for additional coverages or perils insured under endorsements attached)

Subject to Form No(s). attached hereto.
Insert form number(s) and edition date(s)

Mortgage Clause: Subject to the provisions of the mortgage clause attached hereto, loss, if any, on building items, shall be payable to:

Insert name(s) of mortgagee(s) and Mailing address(es)
Agency at

Countersignature Date

.....Agent'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the 11th line from the end and inserting in place thereof the following underlined line:

'Suit. No suit or action on this policy for the recovery of any'

Further amend said Bill at the end by adding the following:
'(Space for insertion of signatures and titles of proper officers)

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 60, §105-B, additional. Chapter 60 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 105-B, to read as follows:

'Sec. 105-B. Conditions numbered consecutively. The lines of the conditions of the standard fire insurance policy shall be numbered consecutively at the option of the Commissioner.'

Sec. 3. Effective date. This act shall take effect January 1, 1962."
