SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 417, L.D. 1356, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Outdoor Advertising on the Interstate
System."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end of section 4
thereof the following sentence:

"For the purpose of implementing section 147-A the
state shall acquire by purchase or condemnation the right to
advertise or regulate advertising in the area adjacent to the
right of way of said system wherein advertising is controlled
by said section, pursuant to section 131 of Title 23, United
States Code, and shall enter into agreements with said
Secretary of Commerce for securing the federal funds for said
purpose referred to therein.
