AN ACT Relating to the Shucking of Shellfish.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 37-A, § 55, sub-§ VII, amended. Subsection VII of section 55 of chapter 37-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 331 of the public laws of 1959, is amended to read as follows:

'VII. Exceptions. ~~The provisions of this~~ This section ~~do not~~ shall apply to shellfish shucked for sale in intrastate trade, ~~nor~~ but not to shellfish shucked in hotels or restaurants for serving on the premises, nor to shucking shellfish at home for home consumption.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 37-A, § 56, sub-§ II, amended. Subsection II of section 56 of chapter 37-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 331 of the public laws of 1959, is amended by adding a new paragraph to read as follows:

'The re-use of any containers used for packing clams is prohibited.'
