SENATE AMENDMENT "D" to H. P. 1080, L. D. 1488, Bill, "An Act  
Establishing Educational Requirements for Insurance Agents  
and Brokers."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out all of paragraph  
A of subsection VII-A and inserting in place thereof the following:

'A. Required courses of instruction. He must have  
completed successfully courses of instruction involving  
at least 32 hours of classroom instruction or its  
equivalent. Such courses of instruction should be  
approved by the commissioner. Such courses may be  
either in attendance at or under the supervision and  
direction of or by correspondence with an educational  
institution or insurance company or association of  
insurance companies approved by the commissioner.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 2.

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 3 and 4  
to be sections 2 and 3.
