RESOLVE, in Favor of Stanley Megquier of Orient.

Stanley Megquier; compensated. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$1,000 to be paid to Stanley Megquier, of Orient, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for damage, not compensated by the State Highway Commission, to his property in constructing highway U. S. #1 (Amity-Orient Project) in 1960.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Megquier's house is now within 15 inches of the U. S. Highway No. 1 and is very undesirable for his children. The house will now have to be moved and the pipes for his well will have to be replaced.
