HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1097, L. D. 1510, Bill, "An Act Relating
to Registration of Motorized Invalid Chairs."

Amend said Bill by striking out the quotation mark at the
end of Sec. 1. and inserting in place thereof the following under-
lined new paragraph:

"Section 45 shall not apply to such invalid chairs but
the Secretary of State shall not issue such registration unless
he is satisfied that such chair is equipped with an adequate
stopping and holding device and means of giving audible signal.' "
