SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1169, L. D. 1614, Bill, An Act Revising
the Election Laws."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "Sec. 10." of section
1 by adding at the end the following subsection section:

'V. Exception in certain municipalities. In a municipality
which has a population of 2,500 or less, the registrar may
place on the voting list those persons whom he believes
qualified to vote without their appearing personally before
him.'
