AN ACT Relating to Special Deputies for Kennebec County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 173, amended. Section 173 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 326 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended to read as follows:

'**Sec. 173. Special deputies in Cumberland and Kennebec Counties; compensation.** The ~~sheriff~~ sheriffs of Cumberland County and Kennebec County shall **respectively** appoint full-time deputy sheriffs, who shall serve at the pleasure of said ~~sheriff~~ **respective sheriffs** and whose special duty shall be to enforce the criminal laws in said ~~county~~ **counties** and who shall receive as compensation therefor the sum of \$11 per day and such additional pay as the **respective** county commissioners may approve, to be paid from the **respective** county ~~treasury~~ **treasuries**, together with such incidental expenses as may be necessary for the proper enforcement of said laws; bills for which shall be audited as provided in chapter 150, section 2.'
