RESOLVE, in Favor of School Administrative District No. 14, Danforth-Weston, for School Construction Aid.

School Administrative District No. 14; school construction aid for. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$20,000 to be paid to School Administrative District No. 14 as a hardship grant for school construction aid. Said sum shall be expended on school construction in School Administrative District No. 14.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The original bid for the new building in School Administrative District No. 14 was \$203,358. This building is being constructed to replace those lost by fire in the Town of Danforth. After cutting out proper floor surfacing, interior and exterior painting and other bare essentials, the bid was let for \$175,500. We had \$50,000 but initial expenses for architect, land, bond issue, legal opinion and other incidentals reduced this to approximately \$33,000. We have borrowed our legal limit of \$117,000 plus our \$63,000 leaves us short about \$20,000 on the minimum building without furnishings. We need \$20,000 to complete the building with proper floor surfacing and interior and exterior painting; the bare essentials for a school building.
