RESOLVE, in Favor of Town of Burlington for Winter Road Maintenance.

Town of Burlington; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated the sum of \$2,092.95 from the General Highway Fund to the Town of Burlington to reimburse the town for salt purchases used in connection with winter road maintenance.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

In 1956, 1957, 1958 and 1959, the Town of Burlington failed to include the cost of salt used on roads in the winter in asking for reimbursement from the State for maintenance of highways. Since the town has a valuation of under \$400,000 the State pays for all maintenance over \$35 per mile.
