COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 273, L.D. 367, Bill, "An Act to Incorporate the City of Belfast as a School Administrative District."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end of section 2 the following paragraph:

'At any time within 4 years after the first meeting of the Directors of said School Administrative District any municipality which is now in the same school union as said City of Belfast may, at a general or special election held in said municipality, vote on the question, "Shall the inhabitants of the Town of ----- (name of ----- join and become a part of the School Administrative District now established in the City of Belfast?"

If a plurality of the votes cast in favor and against joining said district is in the affirmative the town clerk shall notify in writing the Maine School District Commission, or its successor in carrying out said work. After that notice has been forwarded all provisions of law applying to school administrative districts composed of more than one municipality shall apply to this School Administrative District and the board of directors of said district shall be reconstituted in keeping therewith. The City of Belfast or the said School Administrative District shall not be entitled to any vote to prevent any municipality now in the same school union as Belfast from joining said School Administrative District.'
