RESOLVE, Authorizing Survey and Plans for an Interchange to Interstate Highway in the Town of York.

Survey and plans for interchange in Town of York; authorized. Resolved: That the State Highway Commission is authorized and directed to survey and develop plans for the location, cost and type of interchange necessary to provide access to U. S. Route 95 (Maine Turnpike) in the vicinity of State Route 91 in the Town of York; and be it further

Resolved: That the commission shall report the results of the survey with plans at the next regular session of the Legislature; and be it further

Resolved: That there be appropriated from the General Highway Fund for this purpose the sum of \$25,000. Any balance of this appropriation as of June 30, 1964 shall not lapse but be carried forward into the 1964-65 year to be used for the same purposes.
