COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 281, L. D. 375, Bill,  
"An Act Relating to Size of Salmon taken from  
Waters of Aroostook County."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of that part  
designated subsection "I." of section 1 and inserting in  
place thereof the following:

'I. A salmon or togue less than 14 inches in length  
except that the length limit on salmon taken from any  
of the waters in Aroostook County shall be 12 inches;'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section  
2 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 2. Limitation. This act pertaining to the  
Length limit on salmon in Aroostook County shall remain in  
effect only until October 1, 1965.'
