RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing for Bass in Nequasset Pond, Sagadahoc County.

Nequasset Pond; fishing regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation that there be no minimum length or bag limit on the taking of black bass from Nequasset Pond, Woolwich, Sagadahoc County and open season and means of taking bass correspond to general law for trout and salmon.
