IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-THREE

AN ACT to Authorize the Building of a Private Road Across a Portion of Square Pond in Shapleigh.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Treasure Island, Inc. authorized to build a private road. Treasure Island, Inc., a Maine corporation, having a place of business in Sanford, in the County of York and State of Maine, its successors and assigns, are authorized and empowered to build and maintain a private road across a portion of Square Pond, so called, a great pond, situated in Shapleigh, in the County of York, said private road to extend from land owned by said Treasure Island, Inc., on the north-easterly side of said Square Pond to land owned by said corporation known as "Blueberry Island", so called, and lying 200 yards more or less westerly of said first mentioned land of said corporation, provided that a bridge is constructed in said road at least 10 feet in length and of sufficient height to permit the free passage of row boats, canoes, motor boats and their occupants under said bridge.
