CONFERENCE COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 299, L.D. 393, Bill,

"An Act Relating to Definition of "Hotel" Under Liquor Law."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

" 'Each such hotel shall be open for the convenience of the traveling public 7 days per week and a reasonable proportion of the gross income of each such hotel shall be derived from rental of rooms and sale of food; except that a reasonable proportion, but not less than 1/3, of the gross income of each hotel for which a part-time license has been issued shall be derived from rental of rooms and sale of food.'

Sec. 2. Effective date. This act shall become effective for all licenses issued for the calendar year 1965 or any part thereof, and thereafter."
