HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 299, L.D. 393, Bill, "An Act Relating to Definition of "Hotel" Under Liquor Law."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end the following new section:

'<u>Sec. 2. Effective date</u>. This act shall become effective for all licenses issued for the calendar year 1965 or any part thereof, and thereafter.'
