SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 299, L. D. 393, Bill, "An Act Relating
to Definition of "Hotel" Under Liquor Law."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first
line the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end the following
new section:

'Sec. 2. Limitation. This act shall not apply to premises
for which a hotel liquor license was issued in 1963 prior to the
effective date of this act.'
